MINUTES

The Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh shared that Town Vending committee (TVC) has recommended E Sampark Kendra for vendor fee collection from street vendors in the meeting held on 09.02.2017.

The Additional Commissioner-II, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh has briefed that approximate 8623 street vendors are registered in the camp. He also shared that the vending fee from vendors is to be collected on monthly basis. At present, vendors are depositing their monthly fee at counter in Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh. Since, the street vendors are from various locations in the city. Therefore, it is suggested to develop a payment module/application through e Sampark spread over the city

with the help of Department of IT, Chandigarh on the basis of TVC meeting.

The Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh requested Director IT to get the payment application ready for Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh through Society for Promotion of IT (SPIC), Chandigarh Administration.

The Director IT agreed for the work of development of payment module/application for the Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh. Also, MCC and Director IT agreed that SPIC will charge Rs 10.00 +GST rates as applicable for every transaction subject to approval of competent authority.

Director IT agreed that SPIC will do the reconciliation of the amount collected from street vendors on daily basis with MCC.

The Director IT requested that the Data of registered street vendors should be shared with unique ID to SPIC along with vendor fee description for developing of the necessary module & MIS.

It was decided that a joint meeting will be fixed with both the departments under the supervision of the Addition Commissioner-II, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh for further development of application within one week so that the same can be launched.
