

## Declaring Ward No. 5, 6, 11, 12, 19, 20, 23, 24, 25 & 26 as Open Defecation Free

As per the guidelines of Government of India, Chandigarh is implementing Swachh Bharat Mission with a goal of achieving Clean City. The city plans to be Open Defecation Free. In this process, each of the Ward is to be declared Open Defecation Free before the city as a whole is declared as Open Defecation Free. As per the various surveys conducted by the staff of the Municipal Corporation Chandigarh, the following 10 Wards having Sectors/area detailed below have been identified as Open Defecation Free:

19	Sector 26, 26 E, Bapu Dham, Transpt. Camp I-III, Phase I-III, Transport Area, EWS Housing Board & Madrasi Colony (HUTS), Timber Market
20	Sector 29, Industrial Area Phase I, Sanjay Colony (Slum) & Ph. Colony No.4
23	Karsan Colony Phase II, Ram Darbar, Indira Awas Colony, Hallo Majra, Bair Majra, Faidan, Burail & Char Taraf Burail
24	Mauli Complex (Railway Colony, Ambedkar Awas Yojna (Charan Singh Colony), Bhagat Singh Colony, Vikas Nagar, Shivalik Enclave, Mauli Complex (Housing Board
25	Old Manimajra (NAC), Shanti Nagar, Mari Wala Town, Thakur Dwara, Chandigarh House Board 1 & 2, Modern Housing Complex) and Mohalla Govindpura
26	Dhillon Complex, Motor Market, Pocket No. 8, Darshani Bagh, Subhash Nagar, Adarsh Nagar, Pipli Wala Town, Gawala Colony, Indira Colony, Indira Colony (Rehabilitation), Old Indira Colony, Race Course and IT Park

The preliminary resolution is being passed declaring these 10 Wards as ODF as these wards fulfill the following necessary conditions as per instructions of Ministry of Urban Development, New Delhi:

1. All Households that have space to construct toilet, have constructed the one.
2. All occupants of those households that do not have space to construct toilet, have access to community toilet within a distance of 500 metres.
3. All commercial areas have public toilets within a distance of one KM.
4. City has a mechanism in place through which they impose fine on the persons who defecate in open.
