

Declaring Ward No. 8 & 22 as Open Defecation Free

As per the guidelines of Government of India, Chandigarh, is implementing Swachh Bharat Mission with a goal of achieving Clean City. The city plans to be Open Defecation Free. In this process, each of the Ward is to be declared Open Defecation Free before the city as a whole is declared as Open Defecation Free. As per the various surveys conducted by the staff of the Municipal Corporation Chandigarh, the following 2 Wards having Sectors/area detailed below have been identified as Open Defecation Free:

Ward No.	Area
8	Sector 37, 38 & 38 West
22	Sector 31, 47, 48 & Indl. Area Phase II

The preliminary resolution is being passed declaring these 2 Wards as ODF as these wards fulfill the following necessary conditions as per instructions of Ministry of Urban Development, New Delhi:

1. All Households that have space to construct toilet, have constructed the one.
2. All occupants of those households that do not have space to construct toilet, have access to community toilet within a distance of 500 metres.
3. All commercial areas have public toilets within a distance of one KM.
4. City has a mechanism in place through which they impose fine on the persons who defecate in open.
